

Clan Cunningham International Educational Scholarship Fund Application Form

General Information

- Clan Cunningham International, Inc. is pleased to offer educational scholarship awards available
 through this Fund to all CCI members in good standing (age 10 years and older), wishing to
 further their education in studies pertaining to Scotland and/or Clan Cunningham. Studies may
 include but are not limited to: history, culture, music, dance, genealogy, or any other viable
 project that will promote Scottish culture and/or Clan Cunningham in all its manifestations.
- These educational scholarship awards are based on merit and not on financial need.
- All completed applications received by the deadline set by the CCI Educational Scholarship Fund
 Committee will be considered. However, the Committee is not required to make scholarship
 awards during a particular year if no applications are received during that year which in their
 judgment meet the requirements of the program.
- The number and the amounts of scholarship awards made each year are based upon the available funds for that particular year and are determined by the CCI Educational Scholarship Fund Committee.
- Awards are not to be used for expenses incurred in competitions such as piping, dancing, or athletics at Highland Games.
- A CCI member is permitted to receive a CCI ESF award up to four times over his or her lifetime.
- Important considerations for receiving an award will include: active participation in the art form, demonstrated achievement in the art form, and the commitment to further perpetuating Scottish arts and culture or Clan Cunningham. Plans for other viable projects should be well thought out and detailed. Applicants should carefully address these considerations, and be certain that any letter of recommendation submitted also reflects these considerations.
- Do not attach any pictures or videos with this application. Violating this request will invalidate the entire application.

Requirements of CCI ESF Award Recipients

A recipient of a CCI ESF award is required to submit (within two weeks of being notified) a
picture of him or herself and a short biography (200 words or less) to the Committee to be used
for an article about the award that will appear in CCI publications, both in print and online. The
preferred picture should show the recipient wearing or displaying a Scottish tartan, preferably
a Cunningham tartan, in some form. Wearing a Cunningham tartan kilt is not required.

 Upon completion of the training or instruction or the project the CCI ESF award was spent on, the recipient must notify the Committee Chairman of this fact and submit a report within 2 weeks describing it with attached pictures and/or videos if possible and its benefits to him or her and Clan Cunningham. Part or all of these reports and pictures/videos will be published on the CCI website, Face book page and in the CCI newsletter.

Letters of Recommendation:

- Letters of recommendation from a school of instruction, instructor, or project advisor or other are welcomed, but not required.
- For any letter of recommendation submitted, please provide the name, title, address, phone number and email address and relationship to you of the person who writes the letter.
- Any letter submitted should be attached to the application at the time it is submitted to the Chairman of the CCI ESF Committee.

Payment of Awards

- After approval by the CCI ESF Committee and the CCI Governing Council, the notification of
 the award will be made by the Committee Chairman via letter, phone call, or e-mail; at which
 time the recipient must immediately confirm his or her intent to attend the training or course
 of study or do the project the award is to be used.
- The educational scholarship award will be a one-time lump sum amount paid directly to the
 institution in the name of the recipient. Any balance due for tuition, additional fees,
 transportation or supplies is the responsibility of the recipient. CCI ESF does not participate in any
 arrangements between the recipient and the institution. If the recipient does not use the award
 for the intended purpose, then the recipient must coordinate the return of the funds to
 CCI ESF.

Deadline for this application is: May 1 of the year of application Applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered.
